For Your Information:

Brand new books at Burnaby Public Library are often quite popular. Once in a while this may mean you will have to wait for others to finish with the book before you can check it out. Requests are always filled in the order in which they were received. Once you have requested a book there is no need to request it again, we will make sure you get the book when it is your turn.

Renewals:

If there are no requests waiting, Burnaby Public Library materials may be renewed a maximum of two times.

If you would like to renew a book, you can do so in person at any BPL branch, by calling the phone renewal service at 604-293-0034, or online at www.bpl.bc.ca

Requests:

Requests are always welcome so please don't hesitate to ask us about any book you are looking for, even if it's not on this list. If you can only remember part of the information, such as the title, we can always try our best with the information you have given us.

If a book is currently checked out to another reader you can request the item by asking a staff member, through an in-branch public access terminal, or through your home computer. We will let you know when your request can be picked up. Generally, your first 30 annual requests are free; after that it's 50¢ per request.

If the item is sitting on a shelf at another BPL branch then the request is free and is not considered one of your 30 annual requests. The item will be delivered to your BPL branch and we will let you know when you can pick it up.

HOME LIBRARY SERVICE:

Do you enjoy reading, listening to music, or watching movies? Would you like to have library materials delivered to you...**free of charge?!**

If you live in Burnaby and you're unable to get to the library easily on your own, Home Library Service staff can bring you library materials every four weeks. You'll receive an assortment of materials, all based on your own interests that can include:

- Movies, music and magazines
- Hardcover and paperbacks (regular print and large print)
- Audiobooks for those who are unable to read or handle books

Burnaby seniors who don't have their own transportation are also entitled to this free service.
